


## PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

By Assemblyman OWENS

AN ACT concerning the qualification of jurors, and amending N. J. S. 2A:72-7.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. N. J. S. 2A:72–7 is amended to read as follows:

2 2A:72-7. No citizen possessing all other qualifications prescribed 3 by law shall be disqualified for service as a grand or petit juror in any court on account of race, color, creed, national origin, [or] 4 ancestry, \*marital status\* or sex, and any officer or other person  $\mathbf{\tilde{5}}$ charged with any duty in the selection or summoning of jurors who 6 shall exclude or fail to summon any citizen for the cause aforesaid 7 shall, on conviction thereof, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, 8 and be fined not more than \$5,000.00. 9

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
