

- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The value to the well being of the general public of volunteer first aid emergency, ambulance or rescue squads or associations has been recognized. This bill increases the amount a county or municipality may contribute to such associations. The sharp inflationary increase in costs of equipment and services had made an increase in the amount of support necessary if these associations are to continue their important service to the community without loss of efficiency.

Assembly Bill No. 1204 (OCR) is permissive legislation which increases from \$10,000.00 to \$15,000.00 the amount of voluntary contributions that a county or municipality may appropriate to any incorporated first, emergency or volunteer ambulance or rescue squad association providing services in said county or municipality.

This bill is identical to Senate Bill No. 105 which was earlier reported out by the committee and approved by the Senate.
