Assembly Bill No. 517 (Official Copy Reprint) amends the several statutes prescribing salary levels for certain county officers, including county clerks, registers of deeds and mortgages, sheriffs and surrogates.

The minimum salary levels for all such offices are hereby deleted by this bill and the present maximum levels are set as the new minimums, with the maximum levels to be left to the discretion of the board of chosen freeholders.

The minimum salaries for all such offices, therefore, become \$24,000.00 in all counties with a population in excess of 600,000, \$21,000.00 for counties with a population between 400,000 and 600,000, \$18,000.00 for counties with a population between 190,000 and 400,000 and \$15,000.00 for counties with a population of less than 190,000.
