An Act concerning county detectives and amending N. J. S. 2A:157-3.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. N. J. S. 2A:157-3 is amended to read as follows:
- 2 2A:157-3. In counties of the first class there may be appointed
- 3 not in excess of [30] *[35] * *50* county detectives, of whom one
- 4 may be designated chief of county detectives, two *deputy chiefs
- 5 of county detectives, four* captains of county detectives, and not
- 6 more than *[six]* *12* lieutenants of county detectives; their
- 7 annual salaries shall be fixed as follows: chief of county detectives.
- 8 not less than \$11,500.00; *deputy chiefs of county detectives, not
- 9 less than \$11,000.00;* captains of county detectives, not less than
- 10 \$9,500.00; lieutenants of county detectives, not less than \$7,500.00;
- and other county detectives, not less than \$6,500.00.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
