STATEMENT

This bill would amend R. S. 48:12-101 which provides that intrastate tickets for railroad passengers, except excursion tickets or tickets sold at reduced rates, shall be good until used; in other words, shall be valid indefinitely. AMTRAK tickets are valid for 6 months. This bill would make both time limits uniform.
