AN ACT to amend "An act to create a regional agency by inter-governmental compact for the continuing comprehensive, coordinated regional planning for the Delaware Valley Urban Area, and defining the functions, powers and duties of such agency," approved June 18, 1966 (P. L. 1966, c. 149).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Part I, article I, section 7 of P. L. 1966, c. 149 (C. 32:27-7) is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 7. This compact shall continue in existence until **[December 31,**
4 1974. Thereafter it shall continue only upon the adoption of
5 concurrent legislation by the party states**]** *revoked by one of the*
6 *two party states.*

1 2. This bill shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill allows for the extension of the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission's compact to be made on a continuing basis.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets **[thus]** in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
