STATE OF NEW JERSEY

PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

By Senator RUSSO

AN ACT to amend "An act relating to State parks and State forest park reserves and reservations and supplementing Title 13 of the Revised Statutes," approved February 3, 1971 (P. L. 1971, c. 18).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1971, c. 18 (C. 13:2-11) is amended to read 2 as follows:

3 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any rule or regulation of 4 the Department of [Conservation and Economic Development] Environmental Protection no admission fee shall be charged for 56 entrance into any State park or State forest park reserve or reservation by any resident of this State 65 or more years of age or 7who is totally disabled. The Commissioner of [Conservation and 8 Economic Development] Environmental Protection shall by regu-9 lation prescribe the types of evidence which may be used to qualify 10 persons for the benefits of this act. 11

1 2. This act shall take effect 30 days after enactment.
