SPONSOR'S STATEMENT to A3656

There are municipalities which because of their size, topographical contours and geographical features can better assure effective and economical sewerage disposal by participation in two or more sewerage authorities.

This bill would amend existing law to permit a part of a municipality to join a second sewerage authority or district contiguous to the municipality while a portion of the municipality is already part of another sewerage authority or district. Such joinder would require approval by the authority in which the municipality is already a participant.
