Referred to Committee on County and Municipal Government

An Act concerning the compensation of the mayor and the commissioners in certain boroughs and supplementing chapter 72 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the board of com-
- 2 missioners of any borough governed by the commission form of
- 3 government law, and having a population of not less than 1,050 nor
- 4 more than 1,350 inhabitants as ascertained by the latest Federal
- 5 census, may by ordinance fix the annual salary of the mayor at
- 6 \$3,500.00 and of the remaining members of the commission at
- 7 \$3,000.00 each.
- 1 2. Any such ordinance shall become operative in 10 days after
- 2 the publication thereof after its final passage, unless within said
- 3 10 days, a petition, signed by the electors of such borough equal in
- 4 number to at least 10% of the entire vote in the last preceding
- 5 general election, protesting against the passage of such ordinance,
- 6 be presented to the board of commissioners, in which case such
- 7 ordinance shall remain inoperative unless and until a proposition
- 8 for the ratification thereof shall be adopted, at the next general
- 9 election held after the fortieth day following the presentation of
- 10 said petition, by a majority of the qualified voters voting on said
- 11 proposition.
- 1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
