AN ACT to amend "An act authorizing the payment of a pension to the widows of certain former county clerks in counties of the second class," approved May 22, 1968 (P. L. 1968, c. 45).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 1 of the act of which this act is amendatory
2 (C. 43:9-40) is amended to read as follows:

3 1. The board of chosen freeholders of any county of the second
4 class may, in its discretion, adopt a resolution providing for the
5 payment of a pension to any widow of any former county clerk who
6 retired after having served in such capacity continuously for a
7 period in excess of 15 years and who prior to his service as county
8 clerk had served the county in one or more offices, positions or em-
9 ployments continuously for an additional period in excess of 15
10 years, making a total period of service in excess of 30 years. Such
11 widow shall receive from the county, during the term of her natural
12 life, or as long as she remains unmarried, an annual pension equal
13 to $\frac{1}{3}$ of the annual salary paid to her husband at the time of his
14 **[death]** retirement. The pension shall be paid in equal monthly
15 installments by the county treasurer, out of county funds when so
16 directed by the board of chosen freeholders of the county.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately and be retroactive to
2 May 22, 1968.
