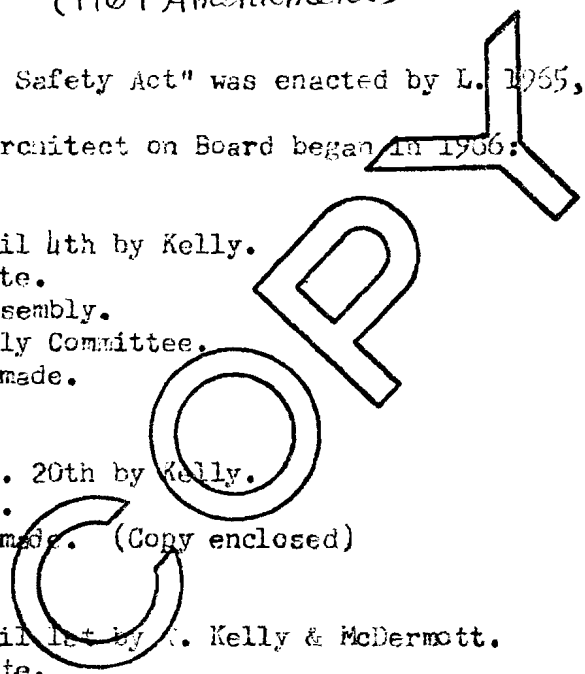

AN ACT to amend "An act concerning worker health and safety and establishing a Bureau of Engineering and Safety in the Department of Labor and Industry; establishing the New Jersey State Industrial Safety Committee and the Industrial Safety Board in the Department of Labor and Industry; supplementing Title 34 of the Revised Statutes and repealing sections 34:1-29 to 34:1-33, inclusive, 34:1-37, 34:6-1 to 34:6-47, inclusive, 34:6-48 to 34:6-67.1, inclusive, 34:6-99 to 34:6-104, inclusive, and 34:6-137 to 34:6-143, inclusive of the Revised Statutes," approved July 19, 1965 (P. L. 1965, c. 154).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 16 of the act of which this act is amendatory (C.
2 34:6A-16) is amended to read as follows:

3 16. There is hereby established within the department an in-
4 dustrial safety board. The board shall consist of **[14]** 15 members,
5 all of whom shall be residents of the State of New Jersey; **[13]** 14
6 appointed by the Governor and the commissioner who shall serve
7 as chairman. Members appointed by the Governor shall be ap-
8 pointed for a 4-year term commencing on July 1 of the year of
9 appointment, except that of those first appointed, 3 shall be ap-
10 pointed for a term of 1 year, 3 for a term of 2 years, **[3]** 4 for a
11 term of 3 years, and 4 for a term of 4 years, which terms shall
12 commence on July 1, 1965. Each member shall hold over after the
13 expiration of his term until his successor has been appointed and
14 has qualified. The Governor may remove any appointed member
15 of the board for cause after a public hearing.

10 term of 3 years, and 4 for a term of 4 years, which terms shall commence
11 on July 1, 1965. Each member shall hold over after the expiration of his
12 term until his successor has been appointed and has qualified. The Gov-
13 ernor may remove any appointed member of the board for cause after a
14 public hearing.

15 Of the members appointed by the Governor, one member shall be
16 selected from a list of names submitted by the American Society of Safety

22 sociation; one member from a list of names submitted by the American
23 Mutual Insurance Alliances; one member from a list of names submitted by
24 the New Jersey State Chamber of Commerce; one member from a list of
25 names submitted by the New Jersey Manufacturer's Association; one
26 member from a list of names submitted by the South Jersey Manufacturers'
27 Association; one member from a list of names submitted by the Medical
28 Society of New Jersey; *one member from a list of names submitted by New*
29 *Jersey Society of Architects, a Chapter of the American Institute of Archi-*
30 *tects*; one member from a list of names submitted by New Jersey Society

41 board shall meet at such time as the commissioner may designate at the
42 time and place selected by him. A meeting of the board shall be called by
43 the commissioner when requested by any 3 members of the board. The head
44 of the bureau shall serve as secretary of the board.
