- 5 (a) Any insurance company authorized to do business in the

- 7 (b) State associations and Federal associations, as defined in

- 9 (c) The inclusion or deduction of a charge for insurance [in
- 10 accordance with the provisions of chapter 10 of Title 17 of the
- 11 Revised Statutes relating to small loans or the inclusion of a charge
- 12 for insurance in connection with an installment sale of a motor
- 13 vehicle or other goods made in accordance with the New Jersey
- 14 Retail Installment Sales Act of 1960, made pursuant to any other
- 15 law of this State expressly or impliedly authorizing the financing
- 16 of insurance premiums in connection with transactions of loan or
- 17 of the sale of goods or services, or both goods and services, includ-
- 18 ing, but not limited to charges for premiums for either or both
- 19 credit life insurance and credit accident and health insurance
- 20 issued pursuant to "An act to provide for the regulation of credit
- 21 life insurance and credit accident and health insurance, as defined,
- 22 and supplementing Title 17 of the Revised Statutes," approved

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to make it clear that the financing of premiums on life and credit accident and health insurance does not fall within the provisions of the Insurance Premium Finance Company Act.
