1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 9 of P. L. 1957, c. 146 (C. 30:9A-9) is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 9. a. Reimbursement grants shall be paid to an eligible sponsor-
4 ing agency from State funds in an amount not exceeding 60% of
5 the allowable expenditures for each project approved by the com-
6 missioner. Allowable expenditures shall include expenditures other
7 than capital expenditures for such purposes as the commissioner
8 shall, by regulation, determine to be necessary or required to carry
9 out the mental health project, except that expenditures for rental
10 or improvements to premises used for the project shall not be
11 included. The total of the annual reimbursement grants from State
12 funds for all community *mental* health projects, exclusive of
13 capital expenditures, in any one county shall not exceed an amount
14 equal to **[\$0.25]** \$0.50 ***[for all counties]*** multiplied by the popula-
15 tion of that county.

16 To permit initiation or expansion of services, the commissioner
17 may make payments in advance to any sponsoring agency of
18 amounts not to exceed 25% of the amount of an approved annual
19 grant to the agency.

20 b. Claims for State reimbursement to the sponsoring agency
21 shall be made in accordance with the regulations of the department.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

14 to **[\$0.25]** *\$0.50 for all counties* multiplied by the population of
15 that county.

16 To permit initiation or expansion of services, the commissioner
17 may make payments in advance to any sponsoring agency of
18 amounts not to exceed 25% of the amount of an approved annual
19 grant to the agency.

20 b. Claims for State reimbursement to the sponsoring agency
21 shall be made in accordance with the regulations of the department.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
