# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED JANUARY 27, 1969

By Senator HAUSER

Referred to Committee on Commerce, Industry and Professions

AN ACT to amend "An act providing for the certification of professional librarians and providing for the employment of professional librarians by the officer or body having charge and control of any library supported in whole or in part by public funds within this State, except a board of education, in certain cases," approved May 9, 1947 (P. L. 1947, c. 132), as said Title was amended by chapter 152 of the laws of 1956.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1947, c. 132 (C. 45:8A-1) is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 1. The State Board of Examiners shall, upon application, issue  
4 to any person a professional librarian's certificate to act as a pro-  
5 fessional librarian if he shall be a graduate from a library school  
6 accredited by the State Board of Education and shall meet such  
7 other requirements as shall be fixed by the State Board of Educa-  
8 tion for the issuance of such certificates except that the State Board  
9 of Examiners shall, upon application, issue such certificate to any  
10 person holding, at the time this act becomes effective, a professional  
11 office, or position, that requires for adequate performance the knowl-  
12 edge and techniques of library science as taught in accredited  
13 library schools, in any library within this State supported in whole  
14 or in part by public funds, except in a library under the charge and  
15 control of a board of education, provided such application is made  
16 within 3 years from the effective date of this act *or in the case of a*  
17 *veteran of World War II, such a certificate shall be issued to any*  
18 *person holding such a professional office or position, who has held*  
19 *the same since November 1, 1957, provided application is made*  
20 *within 30 days of the enactment of this amendatory act.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
