STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 3, 1969

By Senators BATEMAN, SEARS, HIERING and CRABIEL

Referred to Committee on Education

AN ACT concerning education, and supplementing chapter 71 of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 18A:71-7 of Title 2 18A of the New Jersey Statutes, any graduate of a county college, 3 or of a qualified county-assisted junior college, who otherwise 4 qualifies for a State competitive scholarship and who, after admis-5 sion to a 4-year institution of collegiate grade is unable to attend 6 such institution without financial assistance, may apply for a State 7 competitive scholarship.

1 2. The State Scholarship Commission shall, upon verification of $\mathbf{2}$ such applications, without further competitive examinations, award State competitive scholarships to the extent of such appro- $\mathbf{3}$ 4 priations as may be made for such scholarships under the same conditions as other State competitive scholarships are awarded. 5 The State Scholarship Commission is authorized to adopt such rules 6 and regulations as it deems necessary and desirable to effect the 7 8 purposes of this act.

1 3. There is hereby appropriated for the purposes of this act the 2 sum of \$250,000.00 for the fiscal year 1969-1970.

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
