AN ACT concerning the possession of firearms while on the premises of a public or private school, college or university, providing penalties for the violation thereof, and supplementing chapter 151 of Title 2A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Any person other than those enumerated in section 2A:151-43
2 of the New Jersey Statutes, who carries, holds or possesses on or
3 about his clothes or person, or who keeps otherwise in his posses-
4 sion or control while on the premises of any public or private school,
5 college or university, any firearm as defined in section 2A:151-1
6 of the New Jersey Statutes is guilty of a high misdemeanor.

1 2. It shall be no defense to a violation of section 1 of this act
2 that the defendant possessed a valid permit to carry a pistol or
3 revolver or a valid firearms purchaser identification card, unless
4 the holder of such permit or card was in the employ of the school,
5 college or university as a security guard.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

Amend page 1, section 2, line 4, after the word "card", delete "was in the employ of the school, college or university as a security guard", and insert in lieu thereof, the following: "has acquired the written consent from the governing officer of such institution herein above set forth".

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
