AN ACT concerning railroads, and amending sections 48:12-109  
through 48:12-111 of the Revised Statutes.

1 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 48:12-109 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 48:12-109. The following persons, during their respective terms  
4 of office or employment, shall pass and repass, free of charge, in  
5 regular coach service, over all railroads operating such passenger  
6 service, in this State within the borders of this State:

7 The Governor, Chancellor, Vice-Chancellors, Justices of the Su-  
8 preme Court and judges of the court of errors and appeals, judges  
9 of the circuit court, Attorney General and his legal assistants,  
10 secretary and assistant Secretary of State, State Treasurer, deputy  
11 State Treasurer, State Comptroller, deputy State Comptroller,  
12 assistant to comptroller, State Tax Commissioner, chief engineer  
13 in the Division of Railroad Valuation of the State Tax Department,  
14 State supervisor of inheritance tax, members and secretary of the  
15 State Board of Tax Appeals, standing advisory masters of the  
16 court of chancery, clerk and deputy clerk in chancery, Clerk of the  
17 Supreme Court, adjutant general, quartermaster general, secretary  
18 to the Governor, executive clerk, clerk to the school fund, State  
19 Librarian, custodian of the Capitol, keeper and supervisor of the  
20 State Prison, superintendent of the New Jersey reformatory, Com-  
21 missioner and assistant commissioners of Education, members,  
22 secretary and protectors of the Board of Fish and Game Commis-  
23 sioners, Secretary of the State Board of Agriculture, Commissioner  
24 of Banking and Insurance, deputy Commissioners of Banking and  
25 Insurance, chief, division of personal loan agencies of the Depart-  
26 ment of Banking and Insurance, chief, license division of the  
27 Department of Banking and Insurance, insurance investigator of

28 the Department of Banking and Insurance, Commissioner and  
 29 special investigator of the Department of Institutions and Agencies,  
 30 parole agent of the New Jersey State Prison, chief parole  
 30A officer of the New Jersey State Home for Boys, chief parole  
 31 officer of the New Jersey reformatory, field parole officer of the  
 32 New Jersey reformatory, parole officer of the New Jersey State  
 33 Home for Girls, State prison inspectors, general agent and agents  
 34 of the State Board of Children's Guardians, Commissioner of  
 35 Labor, bureau chiefs of the Department of Labor, the members of  
 36 the North Jersey Water Supply Commission, members, counsel,  
 37 secretary and inspectors of the Board of Public Utility Commis-  
 38 sioners, State Highway Commission and its engineer, State Geolo-  
 39 gist, members, chief examiner and secretary of the Civil Service  
 40 Commission, State and assistant State Purchasing Agent, Director  
 41 of Public Record Office, Superintendent of Weights and Measures,  
 42 State Auditor, members of New Jersey Interstate Bridge and Tun-  
 43 nel Commission, members, counsel and secretary of the South Jer-  
 44 sey Port Commission, members, secretaries and engineer of the  
 45 New Jersey Traffic Commission, members of the Rehabilitation  
 46 Commission, members and director of the Board of Conservation  
 47 and Development, members and chief engineer of the Board of  
 48 Commerce and Navigation, members of the Department of Health  
 49 of the State of New Jersey, Director and assistant director of  
 50 Health of the State of New Jersey, members of the Board of Shell  
 51 Fisheries, Director of Shell Fisheries, members and officers of both  
 52 Houses of the Legislature of this State and the members of the  
 53 House of Representatives and United States Senators of New  
 54 Jersey.

1 2. Section 48:12-110 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read  
 2 as follows:

3 48:12-110. The Secretary of State shall issue a certificate in card  
 4 form under his seal of office to each person designated in section  
 5 48:12-109 of this Title. It shall bear the title of such person's office  
 6 or state the capacity in which he is employed by the State, the date  
 7 of issuance to such person and the date of expiration of such per-  
 8 son's office or employment. The certificate shall be signed by the  
 9 Secretary of State and the holder shall indorse his name of the back  
 10 thereof. *The certificate shall set forth the limitations on use con-*  
 11 *tained in section 48:12-111 of this Title.*

12 The Secretary of State shall, within 48 hours after the issuance  
 13 thereof, mail to every railroad company of this State a list of every  
 14 person to whom such certificates have been issued.

15 The Secretary of State may revoke any certificate which is loaned  
16 in violation of section 48:12-112 of this Title.

1 3. Section 48:12-111 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 48:12-111. Such certificate shall be produced and shown on re-  
4 quest of the conductor or person in charge of the train on which  
5 such person is riding. Such presentation shall entitle the person  
6 to whom the certificate is issued to pass and repass without payment  
7 of fare *in regular coach service* on all railroads operating *such*  
8 *passenger service* in this State, within the borders of this State:  
9 *provided, however, that no certificate shall be valid for passage on*  
10 *interstate trains which do not provide intrastate service, or on*  
11 *extra fare or special purpose trains.*

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
