AN ACT to amend "An act concerning alcoholic beverages; limiting the number of licenses to sell alcoholic beverages at retail, and supplementing chapter 1, Title 33, of the Revised Statutes," approved May 1, 1947 (P. L. 1947, c. 94).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 2 of P. L. 1947, chapter 94 (C. 33:1-12.14) is amended  
2 to read as follows:

3 2. Except as otherwise provided in this act, no new plenary  
4 retail consumption or seasonal retail consumption license shall be  
5 issued in a municipality unless and until the combined total number  
6 of such licenses existing in the municipality is fewer than one for  
7 each 2,000 of its population as shown by the **[last then preceding]**  
8 1960 Federal census; and no new plenary retail distribution license  
9 shall be issued in a municipality unless and until the number of  
10 such licenses existing in the municipality is fewer than one for each  
11 5,000 of its population as shown by the **[last then preceding]** 1960  
12 Federal census.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to "freeze" the number of licenses a municipality may issue pursuant to P. L. 1947, chapter 94 (C. 33:1-12.14) at the population recorded for the municipality in the 1960 Federal Decennial Census.

**EXPLANATION**—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets **[thus]** in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
