AN ACT concerning education and amending section 18A:14-12 of
the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 18A:14-12 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 18A:14-12. When a nominating petition is found to be defective
4 *excepting as to the number of signatures*, the secretary of the board
5 shall forthwith notify the candidate of the defect and the date when
6 the ballots will be printed and the candidate indorsing the petition
7 may amend the same in form or substance, *but not to add signatures*,
8 so as to remedy the defect at any time prior to said date.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
