AN ACT to amend "An act providing for the licensing and regulation of convalescent and nursing home administrators, and supplementing chapter 11 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes," approved November 26, 1968 (P. L. 1968, c. 356).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 10 of the act of which this act is amendatory
2 (C. 30:11-20) is amended to read as follows:

3 10. The State Board of Control, subject to the approval of the
4 Governor, shall appoint a Nursing Home Administrator's Licensing
5 Board which shall consist of the Commissioner of the Department
6 of Institutions and Agencies; the Commissioner of the Department
7 of Health, and [5] 9 nursing home administrators of recognized
8 ability, 2 of whom shall be registered nurses who are graduates
9 of accredited schools of nursing, licensed by the New Jersey State
10 Board of Nursing to practice nursing in this State, one of whom
11 shall be a fellow of the American College of Nursing Home Ad-
12 ministrators, one of whom shall be a member of the American Col-
13 lege of Nursing Home Administrators, 2 of whom shall be admin-
14 istrators of governmentally operated nursing homes, 2 of whom
15 shall be administrators of nonprofit homes for the aged with li-
16 censed infirmaries, and one of whom shall be a physician licensed
17 to practice medicine in this State. Each member of the board shall
18 have a minimum of not less than 5 years experience as an admin-
19 istrator in the supervision of a convalescent home or private nurs-
20 ing home and shall at all times be licensed as a nursing home
21 administrator pursuant to the terms of this act. The board shall
22 be appointed for terms of 6 years, except when appointed to com-

24 plete an unexpired term. Members whose terms shall expire shall
25 hold office until appointment of their successors. They shall serve
26 without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for actual expenses
27 incurred in the performance of their official duties.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
