AN ACT concerning townships and the term of office of certain appointive officers thereof, and amending section 40:145-13 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 40:145-13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 40:145-13. All appointive officers, except where otherwise pro-
4 vided, shall hold office until January 1 next following their ap-
5 pointment.

6 The township engineer shall hold office for a term not exceeding
7 3 years from January 1 in the year in which he is appointed.

8 The terms of persons holding the position or office of attorney,
9 building inspector, *municipal physician* and treasurer in any town-
10 ship of this State having a population in excess of 24,000 inhab-
11 itants, as determined by the last preceding Federal census, and not
12 having the municipal manager form of government is hereby fixed
13 at 4 years, and any person now holding said position or office in
14 any such township in this State and any persons who may be here-
15 after appointed or elected to either of said positions or offices shall
16 hold said position or office for a term of 4 years from January 1
17 in the year in which said election or appointment was made. The
18 provisions of this section shall not effect or apply to persons now
19 holding or who may hereafter hold either of said positions or
20 offices, who are under tenure of office.

21 Where a vacancy occurs in any appointive office, the township
22 committee shall fill such vacancy for the unexpired portion of
23 the term thereof; except in the case where the township committee
24 shall grant a leave of absence to join any branch of the Armed

25 Forces of the United States. No officer shall hold over in his office
26 after the expiration of the term for which he shall have been ap-
27 pointed.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
