An Act concerning the powers and duties of the Board of Higher Education, supplementing chapter 3 of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

- 1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. The Board of Higher Education shall prepare on an annual
- 2 basis a concise report which lists all sources of financial assistance,
- 3 including but not limited to scholarships and loans, available to
- 4 citizens of this State who now attend or who plan to attend any
- 5 institution of higher education. The report shall supply the name
- 6 and address of each source, identify the form of the financial as-
- 7 sistance, and indicate that the source of funds is public or private.
- 1 2. This report shall be distributed to each public and private
- 2 secondary school in this State, and upon request, to any citizen of
- 3 this State.
- 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Higher
- 2 Education the sum of \$15,000.00 to effectuate the purposes of this
- 3 act.
- 1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
