AN ACT concerning audiovisual education aids, and amending section 18A:51-9 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 18A:51-9 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 18A:51-9. Each county educational audiovisual aids commission  
4 shall forward to the commissioner, on or before September 1 of  
5 each year, a statement of its organization and its proposed program  
6 of operation for the next ensuing school year, together with an  
7 estimate of the amount of State aid, calculated as hereinafter pro-  
8 vided, to which it will be entitled for that school year and it shall  
9 certify, on or before the next June 30, the amount raised by assess-  
10 ments and private donations for the purposes of such audiovisual  
11 center for the said school year and if the amount so raised by  
12 assessments or private donations or both for any one school year,  
13 for the establishment and maintenance or for the maintenance of  
14 such aids center shall be not less than the sum of \$500.00, and if the  
15 commissioner shall approve such organization and program he shall  
16 thereupon certify to the Director of Budget and Accounting in the  
17 Department of the Treasury that there shall be paid to the cus-  
18 todian of moneys of the commission an amount equal to the amount  
19 so raised by assessments and private donations out of any funds  
20 appropriated by law for said purposes, which amount shall be paid  
21 on the warrant of said director drawn on the State Treasurer in  
22 favor of the custodian of moneys of the commission except that the  
23 amount so to be paid by the State to any such commission shall not  
24 exceed the sum of **[\$2,500.00]** \$5,000.00 in any 1 year nor shall it  
25 exceed the sum expended by the commission for educational audio-

26 visual aids purchased by it in any year after the first 5 annual pay-  
27 ments have been made. If the sum appropriated by the State for  
28 State aid to county educational audiovisual centers in any 1 year  
29 shall be less than the total amounts so certified by the commissioner,  
30 each commission shall be entitled to be paid its proportionate share  
31 of the total amount so appropriated.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Assembly Bill No. 489 would increase from \$2,500.00 to \$5,000.00 the amount of State aid the State may pay to a county educational audio visual aids commission.

If the total amount authorized by this legislation were paid to the county commissions, the Department of Education estimates a State expenditure of \$55,000.00 would be required annually.
