PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1969 SESSION

By Senators GUARINI and W. F. KELLY

AN ACT concerning the unclassified service of the civil service and amending section 11:22-2 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 11:22-2 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 11:22-2. The unclassified service shall not be subject to the pro-
4 visions of this subtitle and shall include the following:

5 a. Officers elected by popular vote;

6 b. Members of district boards of elections; employees in voting
7 machine departments and the chief deputy, chief clerk, secretary,
8 clerical and other assistants or employees appointed by the super-
9 intendants of elections and commissioners of registration in coun-
10 ties of the first class having less than 800,000 inhabitants, and by
11 the county boards of elections in all other counties and such of said
12 officers, assistants and employees as are appointed by superintend-
13 ents of elections in counties of the first class having more than
14 800,000 inhabitants to serve for terms of 6 months or less in any
15 1 year;

16 c. Appointments of the mayor;

17 d. Heads of departments, the members of commissions and
18 boards elected by the board of aldermen, common council or other
19 governing body of any county, municipality or school district oper-
20 ating under this subtitle;

21 e. Law officers of a county, municipality or school district operat-
22 ing under this subtitle;

23 f. Superintendents of, teachers and instructors in the public
24 schools and county superintendents and members and business
25 managers of boards of education;

26 g. Police magistrates appointed by the mayor or other head
27 officer of the municipality operating under this subtitle;

28 h. Officers and employees of county park commissioners in coun-
29 ties of the second class appointed under the provisions of sections
30 40:37-96 to 40:37-174 of the Title, Municipalities and Counties;

31 i. The superintendent of a county hospital for persons suffering
32 from communicable diseases appointed under the provisions of sec-
33 tions 30:9-61 and 30:9-69 of the Revised Statutes; and

34 j. The deputy or first assistant of principal executive officers
35 authorized by law to act generally for and in place of his principal;

36 k. The legal assistants of the law department of the counties,
37 municipalities or school districts operating under this subtitle
38 except as herein otherwise provided;

39 l. One secretary, clerk or executive director of each department,
40 appointed board or commission authorized by law to appoint a sec-
41 retary, clerk or executive director;

42 m. One private secretary or clerk or stenographer of each judge
43 or principal executive officer;

44 n. All officials of county *or municipal* institutions who must of
45 necessity be physicians; and

46 o. Such other officers and positions not now included in the un-
47 classified service by this section or by any other statute, as the
48 Civil Service Commission shall, from time to time, determine, ac-
49 cording to law, to be in the unclassified service.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
