INTRODUCED JANUARY 27, 1969

AN ACT requiring constables to file a monthly report of their official activities with the governing body by whom they were elected or appointed, and supplementing chapter 41 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Every constable shall on or before the first Wednesday follow-  
2 ing the first Monday of every month file with the governing body  
3 by whom he was elected or appointed, a report of his official activ-  
4 ities, other than in connection with court or judicial proceedings,  
5 for the month immediately past. The governing body shall forward  
6 a copy of the report to the municipal chief of police.

1 2. The report required by section 1 of this act shall list the names  
2 and addresses of all persons contacted by the constable in his  
3 official capacity, together with the date, time and purpose of the  
4 contact. In addition the report shall contain an accurate statement  
5 of all fees collected by the constable and from whom and for what  
6 service each fee was collected.

1 3. The failure by a constable to file a report, as required by this  
2 act, for 2 consecutive months, unless he was prevented from so  
3 doing by reason of his physical incapacity, shall result in his office  
4 being deemed vacant and he shall be barred from exercising the  
5 rights and privileges thereof.

1 4. Any constable who falsifies the report required by this act  
2 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

1 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
