AN ACT concerning education and amending section 18A:51-6 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 18A:51-6 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 18A:51-6. The commission shall provide, maintain and furnish  
4 educational audiovisual aids to the public schools of the participat-  
5 ing school districts and shall provide such facilities, and may incur  
6 such expenses as it may deem necessary for said purpose, but shall  
7 not make expenditures or commitments in any year in excess of the  
8 funds available for that year.

9 *The commission may contract with nonprofit, private schools*  
10 *within the county to provide, maintain and furnish educational*  
11 *audiovisual aids to such private schools. Before contracting with*  
12 *any nonprofit, private school, the commission shall submit the terms*  
13 *of the contract to the member boards for review, which terms shall*  
14 *include a description of the educational audiovisual aid to be*  
15 *furnished, the amount of payment and the time for payment.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
