STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED JANUARY 27, 1969

By Senators KNOWLTON, STOUT and WOODCOCK

Referred to Committee on County and Municipal Government

AN ACT to require municipalities to grant time off from work with pay for municipal employees who are volunteer firemen, volunteers in first aid or rescue squads or volunteer drivers of municipally-owned or operated ambulances when responding to alarms during the hours of their employment.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Municipalities shall be required to grant time off from work
2 with pay for municipal employees who are members of a volunteer
3 fire company serving the municipality, volunteers in first aid or
4 rescue squads serving the municipality or volunteer drivers of
5 municipally-owned or operated ambulances when such employees
6 are called to respond to alarms occurring during the hours of their
7 employment.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
