1. <sup>2</sup>(New section)<sup>2</sup> a. Upon the application of a person who has served as a municipal mayor for one term or longer but who presently does not occupy that position, the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles shall issue special registration plates for a motor vehicle owned or leased by that person. The plates shall be of a design approved by the director and shall convey appropriate recognition of the person's service as a mayor, in addition to containing the markings or identification otherwise required by law.

b. In addition to the fees otherwise prescribed by law for the registration of motor vehicles, an application for these special plates shall be accompanied by a fee of \$50 <sup>1</sup>which shall be retained by the Division of Motor Vehicles<sup>1</sup> to defray the cost of producing and distributing the plates. The plates shall identify the holder as a "Senate-Former Member" or "General Assembly-Former Member"; provided however, if the former member served in both the General Assembly and the Senate, the former member shall receive plates identifying him as a former member of the Senate. The plates would convey appropriate recognition of the registrant's service as a mayor.

ADOPTED: JUNE 14, 1999

Senate Bill No. 450 (1R) provides for the issuance of special license plates for motor vehicles owned or leased by former municipal mayors who have served at least one term in office.

These Assembly amendments permit former members of the State Legislature to also be issued special license plates. The plates would identify the holder as a former member of either the Senate or the General Assembly and contain the Shield of the State of New Jersey. If the former members served in both houses, the plates would identify the former member as a senator. The Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles would design the plate, subject to approval by the President of the Senate and Speaker of the General Assembly.

Special license plates for former mayors and former State legislators would be available for an additional application fee of \$50. The Division of Motor Vehicles would retain this fee to cover production and administrative costs associated with the issuance of the special license plate.

Senate Bill No. 450 (1R) of 1998 permits the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to issue special license plates to persons who have served at least one term as a municipal mayor but who do not presently hold that office. The director would be authorized to charge an application fee of \$50 for the plates which shall be in addition to all other fees otherwise required by law.

Based on a general model developed by the DMV for various specialty license plate costs, the Office of Legislative Services (OLS) estimates that the cost to produce and mail organization or affiliation plates, such as the proposed mayoral plate, would be about \$10 per set. No marketing or systems programming costs are anticipated to be incurred in connection with issuing these plates because of the limited number of people who would qualify to display the plates on their vehicles.

OLS cannot estimate the level of interest that the former mayors of the various municipalities in the State may have in purchasing the new, special license plates. Consequently, OLS cannot project revenues from application fees that would be available to offset DMV expenses.

This legislative fiscal estimate has been produced by the Office of Legislative Services due to the failure of the Executive Branch to respond to our request for a fiscal note.

This fiscal estimate has been prepared pursuant to P.L.1980, c.67.
