The Senate Education Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 2014.

This bill requires a board of education contracting with public or private agencies for certain services for nonpublic school pupils to provide consultation with representatives of the nonpublic school on any change in the provision of those services. The services that are covered under the bill include examination and classification services for handicapped pupils, speech correction and supplemental instruction, programs for pupils with limited English-speaking ability, and compensatory education.

S-279 (Girgenti) (Russo) - Clarifies duties and responsibilities of municipal prosecutors.

S-504 (Ciesla/Matheussen) (Blee/Malone) - Requires public school districts to provide transportation to all nonpublic schools in certain situations.

S-912 (Palaia/Bark) (Roberts/Geist) - Authorizes certain charges to office of county fire marshal and allows creation of arson investigation unit therein.
