9 the contrary, a municipality designated as an urban enterprise zone
10 pursuant to the provisions of P.L.1983, c.303 (C.52:27H-60 et seq.)
11 shall be considered by the commissioner for assistance under the "Main
12 Street New Jersey" program if such municipality includes financial
13 assistance from its enterprise zone assistance fund account, established
14 pursuant to section 29 of P.L.1983, c.303 (C.52:27H-88), for the
15 purpose of having an operating budget deemed adequate by the
16 commissioner for a period of not less than three years and if such
17 municipality is otherwise eligible for assistance pursuant to the
18 provisions of section 3 of P.L.2001, c.238 (C.52:27D-454). ¹Any
19 proposal by such municipality for financial assistance from its

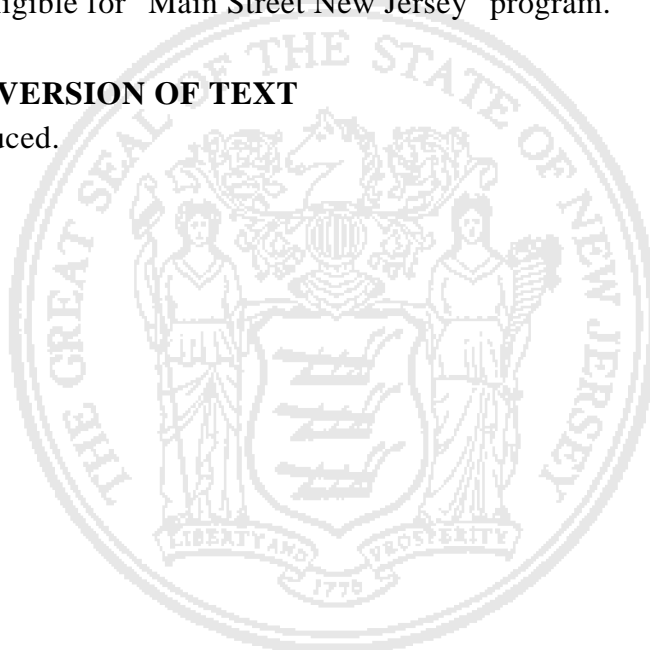

The Senate Economic Growth, Agriculture and Tourism Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 2424 with committee amendments.

This bill, as amended, would allow a municipality that is designated as an urban enterprise zone pursuant to the provisions of P.L.1983, c.303 (C.52:27H-60 et seq.) to be considered by the Commissioner of Community Affairs for assistance under the "Main Street New Jersey" program if that municipality includes financial assistance from its enterprise zone assistance fund account, established pursuant to section 29 of P.L.1983, c.303 (C.52:27H-88), for the purpose of having an operating budget deemed adequate by the commissioner for a period of not less than three years and if such municipality is otherwise eligible for assistance pursuant to the provisions of section 3 of P.L.2001, c.238 (C.52:27D-454).

The committee amended the bill to provide that any proposal by such municipality for financial assistance from its enterprise zone assistance fund account, for the purposes of consideration by the commissioner for assistance under the "Main Street New Jersey" program, shall follow the procedures for approval that are established pursuant to the provisions of section 29 of P.L.1983, c.303 (C.52:27H-88).

As amended and reported by the committee, Assembly Bill, No. 2424 is identical to Senate Bill, No. 1559 which also was amended and reported by the committee on this date.

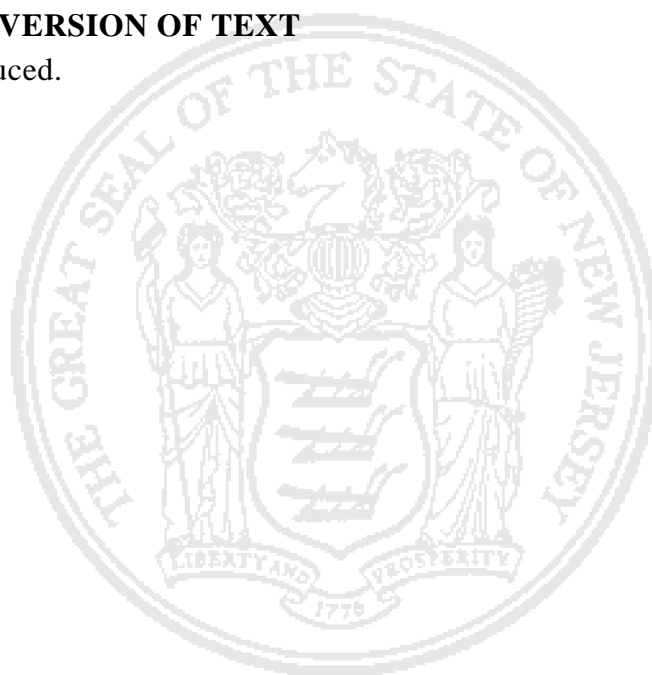
