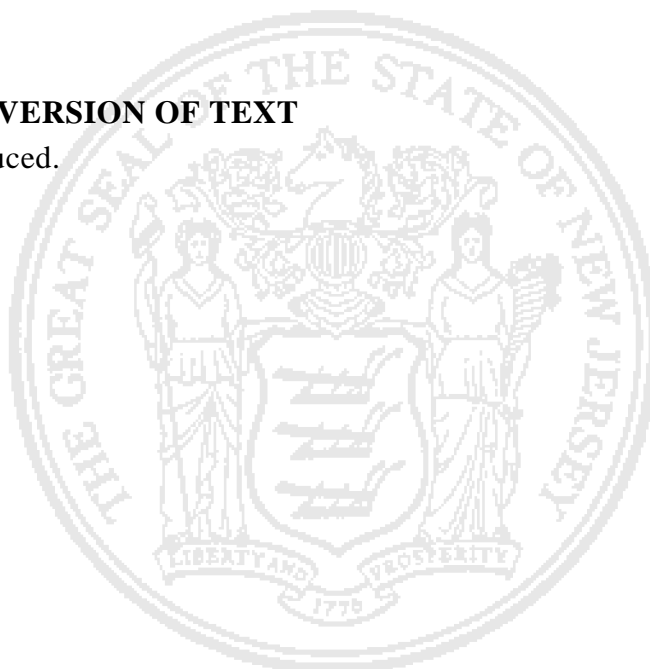

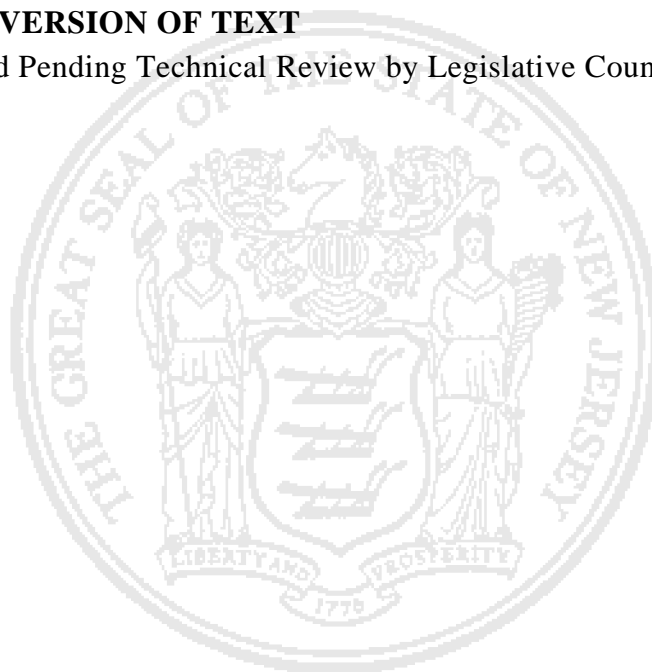

The Assembly Law and Public Safety Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Assembly Bill No. 1295.

As amended, Assembly Bill No. 1295 designates the New Jersey Law Enforcement Memorial and Museum in Madison Boro as the official entity constructing the law enforcement memorial and museum of the State of New Jersey.

According to the sponsor, the New Jersey Law Enforcement Memorial and Museum was founded for the purpose of dedicating a permanent memorial to New Jersey police officers killed in the line of duty. Designating the organization as the official entity constructing the memorial and museum will enable it to pursue funding sources, such as federal grants or donations from charitable organizations.

As amended and released by the committee, this bill is identical to Senate Bill No. 1470, also released by the committee on this same date.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2004 legislative session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

The committee amended the bill to specify that the New Jersey Law Enforcement Memorial and Museum is located in Madison Boro.
