The Assembly Education Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 1205 with committee amendments.

As amended, this bill prohibits a public or independent institution of higher education in the State from displaying any student's Social Security number to identify that student for posting or public listing of grades, on class rosters or other lists provided to teachers, on student identification cards, and in student directories or similar listings, unless otherwise required in accordance with applicable State or federal law.

The committee amended the bill to revise its effective date from the 30th day following the bill's enactment to the 365th day.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2004-2005 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.
