1 **AN ACT** creating a World War II Veterans' Memorial Fund and
2 supplementing Title 38A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. There is created in the Department of the Treasury a dedicated,
8 non-lapsing fund to be known as the World War II Veterans' Memorial
9 Fund. The fund shall be credited with any money received by the
10 World War II Memorial Commission established pursuant to Executive
11 Order No. 107 of 2004 by Governor McGreevey through fundraising
12 efforts and as donations or grants, and any monies as may thereafter
13 be donated by members of the public or appropriated to the fund by
14 law. All interest on monies in the fund shall be credited to the fund.
15 Investment of such monies shall be consistent with policies of the
16 Division of Investment. The monies in the fund shall be administered
17 by the State Treasurer, to be held in the fund until appropriated by
18 law. Not later than 180 days after the effective date of this act, and
19 periodically thereafter, the State Treasurer shall certify to the
20 Legislature the total amount of monies in the fund.

22 2. The Adjutant General of the Department of Military and
23 ¹[Veterans] Veterans¹ Affairs and the Deputy Commissioner of
24 Veterans' Affairs, on behalf of the World War II Memorial
25 Commission established pursuant to Executive Order No. 107 of 2004
26 by Governor McGreevey, may solicit and accept donations or grants
27 of money or property from any source for the purposes of the World
28 War II Memorial and may distribute appropriations made by law for
29 that purpose. Any donations or grants received shall be credited to

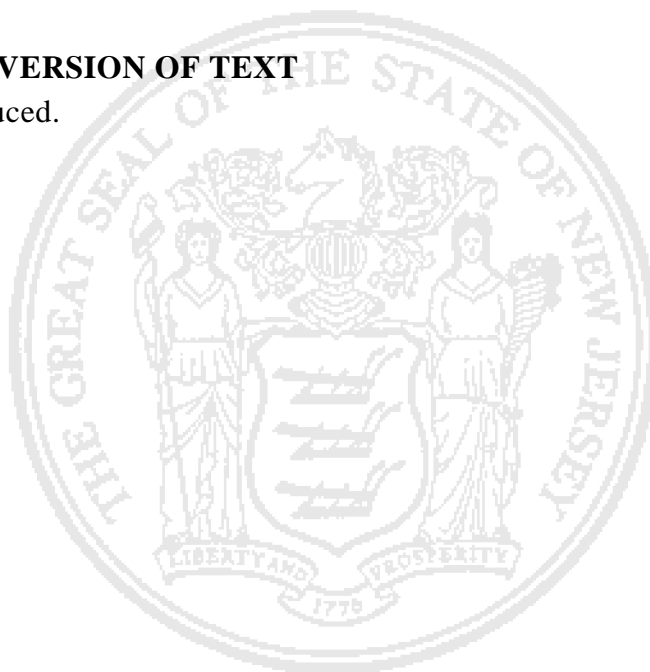
