

The Assembly Regulated Professions and Independent Authorities Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 3829.

This bill provides that applicants for licensure as a certified public accountant are required to complete at least 120 semester hours of education to sit for the licensure examination and have a baccalaureate degree or higher degree or its equivalent, but they must satisfactorily complete at least 150 semester hours before they may be licensed. The bill removes the current provision of law stipulating that an applicant who applies prior to July 1, 2005 shall qualify for examination for licensure if he has only a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent, but shall not be issued a license unless he has successfully completed at least 150 semester hours.

The Senate Commerce Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Senate Bill No. 2408.

As amended, this bill provides that applicants for licensure as a certified public accountant are required to complete at least 120 semester hours of education to sit for the licensure examination and have a baccalaureate degree or higher degree or its equivalent, but they must satisfactorily complete at least 150 semester hours before they may be licensed. The bill removes the current provision of law stipulating that an applicant who applies prior to July 1, 2005 shall qualify for examination for licensure if he has only a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent, but shall not be issued a license unless he has successfully completed at least 150 semester hours.

The committee amended the bill to specify that the 150 hours of education, including the 30 additional hours required for licensure, must include a concentration in accounting or its equivalent and related professional courses.

[First Reprint] SENATE, No. 2408

with Senate Floor Amendments (Proposed By Senators KENNY and SINGER)

ADOPTED: JUNE 20, 2005

The bill provides that applicants for licensure as certified public accountants are required to complete at least 120 semester hours of education to sit for the licensure examination, but they must satisfactorily complete at least 150 hours before they may be licensed. The amendments remove the provision in the bill that the 30 additional hours of the education program required for the issuance of a license must include a concentration in accounting or its equivalent and related professional courses.
