The Assembly Education Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 1034.

This bill requires the board of trustees of a county college to provide to a member of the non-academic support staff who has been employed for at least one year a notice not less than 30 days prior to the date of the layoff of the member which is necessary for reasons of financial exigency or enrollment decline. If the member has been employed for less than one year, the board must provide a notice of not less than 14 days prior to the date of the layoff.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2004-2005 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.

As reported, Senate Bill No. 849 is identical to Assembly Bill No. 1034.
