4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

8 Vehicles suggesting] New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission
9 requesting¹ that a family member be ¹given a medical review or be¹
10 retested to determine whether that family member is capable of safely
11 operating a motor vehicle in this State, ²upon a request by the person
12 who contacted the commission,² the ¹[division] commission¹ shall
13 send ¹[a copy of any notice requiring] confirmation that a notice has
14 been sent regarding a medical review or¹ retesting of the family
15 member to the person who contacted the ¹[division] commission¹.

16 b. Whenever the ¹[Division of Motor Vehicles] commission¹ is
17 required to send a ¹[second] subsequent¹ notice ¹[requiring]
18 regarding a medical review or¹ retesting in order to determine whether

20 this State because there was no response to the first such notice,

13 second notice requiring retesting in order to determine whether such
14 a family member is capable of safely operating a motor vehicle in this
15 State because there was no response to the first such notice, the
16 division shall also send a copy of that second notice.

STATEMENT

22

23 This bill would entitle certain persons to notification whenever a
24 family member is subject to retesting by the Division of Motor
25 Vehicles (DMV) in order to determine whether that person is capable
26 of safely operating a motor vehicle in this State.

27 Under the provisions of the bill, persons who suggest to the DMV
28 that a family member should be retested would be entitled to a copy of
29 any DMV notice or second notice requiring that relative to submit to
30 retesting. Sending a copy of the retesting notice to a family member
31 would promote the retesting process. If another family member is
32 aware of the retesting request, it is less likely that the request will be
33 misplaced, forgotten or ignored.

The Assembly Transportation Committee reports favorably and with amendments Assembly Bill No. 1188.

This amended bill provides that whenever a person contacts the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission requesting that a family member be given a medical review or be retested to determine whether that family member is capable of safely operating a motor vehicle, the commission shall send a confirmation that a notice has been sent regarding a medical review or retesting to the person who contacted the commission.

If subsequent notices are required, the commission shall also send confirmation of those notices to the person who originally contacted the commission.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2004-2005 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

The amendments by the Committee change the bill's requirement that the commission should provide a copy of a notice of retesting to the family member who contacted the commission to requiring that the commission provide a confirmation that a notice regarding a medical review or retesting had been sent to the family member who contacted the commission. The amendments made the same changes in the provision of the bill concerning subsequent notices.

The Senate Transportation Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 1188 (2R).

This bill provides that whenever a person contacts the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission requesting that a family member be given a medical review or be retested to determine whether the family member is capable of safely operating a motor vehicle, if requested, the commission shall send a confirmation to the person who contacted the commission that a notice has been sent regarding a medical review or retesting. If a subsequent notice is required, the commission shall also send confirmation of the subsequent notice.

As reported by the committee, Assembly Bill No. 1188(2R) is identical to Senate Bill No. 1836 which was also reported by the committee on this date.
