Be It Enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. Section 54 of P.L.2002, c. 34 (C.App.A:9-78) is amended to read as follows:
2. a. As used in this section:
"Rental company" means a person engaged in the business of renting motor vehicles.
"Rental motor vehicle" means a passenger automobile, truck or semitrailer that is rented without a driver and used in the transportation of persons or property other than commercial freight.
b. Each rental company doing business in this State shall pay a fee for each rental motor vehicle that the company shall have rented from a location in this State under the terms of a rental agreement for a period of not more than 28 days. The amount of the fee shall be [\$2] ${ }^{1}$ [\$4] \$5 ${ }^{1}$ for each day or part thereof that each such vehicle was rented. The fee shall be separately stated to the person to whom the motor vehicle is rented and shall not be included in the receipts subject to the taxes imposed pursuant to the "Sales and Use Tax Act," P.L.1966, c. 30 (C.54:32B-1 et seq.).

The director of the Division of Taxation in the Department of the Treasury shall collect and administer the fee; in so doing, the director shall have all the powers granted pursuant to P.L.1966, c. 30 (C.54:32B-1 et seq.). The director may, pursuant to the provisions of the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c. 410 (C.52:14B1 et seq.), make, adopt, amend or repeal such rules and regulations as the director finds necessary to carry out the provisions of this subsection.
c. There is established in the General Fund the New Jersey Domestic Security Account, which shall be a dedicated nonlapsing account. Amounts paid to the State Treasurer from the first $\$ 2$ of the fee for each day or part thereof that a rental motor vehicle was rented pursuant to subsection b. of this section shall be deposited into the account upon receipt. Moneys in the account, including interest thereon, shall be available exclusively for appropriation to support medical emergency disaster preparedness for bioterrorism, security coverage at nuclear power facilities, State Police salaries related to Statewide security services, and counter-terrorism programs.

#### Abstract

The Assembly Budget Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 4715, with committee amendments.

Assembly Bill No. 4715, as amended, raises the surcharge on motor vehicle rentals from $\$ 2$ per day to $\$ 5$ per day. While leaving the statutory dedication of the first $\$ 2$ per day surcharge intact, the bill's additional revenue would support the State General Fund.

Section 54 of P.L.2002, c. 34 (C.App.A:9-78) currently requires the Director of the Division of Taxation to collect a $\$ 2$ per day surcharge on motor vehicle rentals and to place the proceeds in the New Jersey Domestic Security Account. The dedicated revenues are intended to exclusively support medical emergency disaster preparedness for bioterrorism, security coverage at nuclear facilities, State Police salaries related to Statewide security services, and counter-terrorism programs.


## FISCAL IMPACT

The Governor's Fiscal Year 2007 Budget anticipates $\$ 23.5$ million from the current $\$ 2$ surcharge. This bill increases the amount expected by $\$ 35.25$, for a total of $\$ 58.75$ million. The additional surcharge is deposited in the General Fund.
