1 **AN ACT** clarifying the authority of the Department of  
2 Transportation to enter into certain agreements with local  
3 governments and supplementing Title 27 of the Revised Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
6 *of New Jersey:*  
7

8 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S.27:7-11, R.S.27:7-21,  
9 R.S.27:7-29, P.L.1966, c.185 (C.27:7-35.1 et seq.), and any other  
10 law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the Commissioner of  
11 Transportation may enter into a contract or agreement with a county  
12 or municipality for repair or routine maintenance of State highways  
13 without advertisement for bids therefor, if the scope of the work  
14 required does not contemplate the award of a contract by the county  
15 or municipality to an outside contractor. This authorization shall  
16 not apply if approval by the Federal Highway Administration of the  
17 repair or maintenance is required.

19 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

22 **STATEMENT**  
23

24 This bill would permit the Commissioner of Transportation to  
25 enter into contracts or agreements with counties or municipalities  
26 for repair or routine maintenance work on State highways without  
27 the contract or agreement being required to be put out to bid by  
28 public advertisement. Examples of routine maintenance could  
29 include culvert cleaning, snow plowing, traffic light repair, etc.  
30 The bill would permit the State to take advantage of any cost  
31 savings which may be available on State highway work through  
32 contracting with a county or municipality for such work. The Local  
33 Public Contracts Law already permits localities to enter into  
34 contracts with public entities without the necessity for public  
35 bidding.
