The Senate Community and Urban Affairs Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 638.

This bill would amend the provisions of the "Local Public Contracts Law," P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-1 et seq.) and the "Public School Contracts Law," N.J.S.18A:18A-1 et seq., concerning the requirements for bidding on public contracts and public school contracts, to prohibit the date fixed for receiving the bids to fall on a Monday, or any day directly following a State or federal holiday.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2006-2007 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.
