The Assembly State Government Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 2483 (1R).

This bill provides that members of a board of trustees for a local pension fund of school district employees in a first class county will be reimbursed for necessary expenditures, and that they will not suffer a loss of salary or wages through serving on the board. Similar provisions currently exist for boards of trustees for the Stateadministered Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund and Public Employees' Retirement System. Current law provides that board members, other than the secretary and treasurer, serve without compensation. The compensation of the secretary and treasurer is set by the board.

The bill adds the position of vice-chairperson to the board of trustees, which may currently exist pursuant to the bylaws of the board, and provides that the treasurer may be a member of the board of trustees.

Senate Bill No. 2483 (1R) is identical to Assembly Bill No. 2318 (1R) of 2006.

The Senate State Government Committee reports without recommendation and with committee amendments Senate Bill No. 2483.

This bill provides that certain members of a board of trustees for a pension fund of school district employees in a county of the first class will serve without compensation, but will be reimbursed for necessary expenditures. Under the bill, no employee who is a trustee will suffer the loss of salary or wages while serving on the board.

The bill also provides that the person serving as treasurer may be a member of the board.

The bill's provisions concerning compensation do not apply to the secretary and treasurer because current law already provides for their compensation to be fixed by the board of trustees.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

The committee amended the bill to update the section of law it amends to be the most recent version of current law.

Similar provisions currently exist for boards of trustees for the Stateadministered Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund and Public Employees' Retirement System. Current law provides that board members, other than the secretary and treasurer, serve without compensation. The compensation of the secretary and treasurer is set by the board.

The bill adds the position of vice-chairperson to the board of trustees, which may currently exist pursuant to the bylaws of the board, and provides that the treasurer may be a member of the board of trustees.

Assembly Bill No. 2318 (1R) is identical to Senate Bill No. 2483 (1R) of 2007.
