FISCAL ANALYSIS

EXECUTIVE BRANCH

According to the Division on Taxation, Department of Treasury, enactment of this bill will have no impact on the General Fund, except for a minimal administrative cost in the first year to implement the proposal. The division indicated that there was no way to determine how much would be contributed to the "New Jersey Veterans Haven Support Fund" nor any way to estimate what impact this designation would have on the existing funds.

The division listed the amounts designated by checkoff and numerical designation to the eleven charitable funds that have been included on tax forms through tax year 2005. Those amounts are as follows:
