# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

### DATED: DECEMBER 17, 2007

The Senate Law and Public Safety and Veterans' Affairs Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Senate Bill No. 317.

Senate Bill No. 317 abolishes the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship Commission and the Foundation for the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship. Because of the elimination of the commission and the foundation, references to them are removed from statutes establishing the "Battleship New Jersey Memorial Fund" (based upon issuance of a special license plate) and the "U.S.S. New Jersey Educational Museum Fund" (based upon a State income tax checkoff).

As amended, this bill clarifies that all funds of the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship Commission and the Battleship New Jersey Memorial Fund are to be transferred to the Home Port Alliance. Additionally, all funds of the Foundation for the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship are transferred to the Foundation for the Battleship New Jersey. Revenue generated under the "Battleship New Jersey Memorial Fund" (based upon issuance of a special license plate) and the "U.S.S. New Jersey Educational Museum Fund" (based upon a State income tax checkoff) is to be appropriated to the Home Port Alliance.

The committee amended the bill to:

(1) clarify that funding deposited in the U.S.S. New Jersey Educational Museum Fund is to be annually appropriated to the Home Port Alliance;

(2) clarify that all funds of the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship Commission and the Battleship New Jersey Memorial Fund are to be transferred to the Home Port Alliance, and that all funds of the Foundation for the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship are transferred to the Foundation for the Battleship New Jersey;

(3) eliminate the requirement that all funds of the commission and the foundation are to be transferred to the State Treasurer for deposit in a special dedicated account; and

(4) omit the term "acquisition" from the statutes establishing the issuance of the "Battleship U.S.S. New Jersey" license plate.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2006-2007 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.

As amended and reported by the committee, this bill is identical to Assembly Bill No. 2538 (2R).

The Assembly Law and Public Safety Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Assembly Bill No. 2538.

Assembly Bill No. 2538 abolishes the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship Commission and the Foundation for the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship. Because of the elimination of the commission and the foundation, references to them were removed from statutes establishing the "Battleship New Jersey Memorial Fund" (based upon issuance of a special license plate) and the "U.S.S. New Jersey Educational Museum Fund" (based upon a State income tax checkoff).

Under the amended bill, the term "acquisition" has also been removed from the statutes establishing the issuance of the "Battleship U.S.S. New Jersey" license plate since the ship has been acquired by the State since the enactment of the statute.

The amended bill clarifies that funding deposited in the U.S.S. New Jersey Educational Museum Fund is to be annually appropriated to the Home Port Alliance for the maintenance and operation of the Battleship New Jersey now sited at its permanent berth in New Jersey.

It is the committee's understanding that all revenue of the U.S.S. New Jersey Battleship Commission would be transferred to the Home Port Alliance.

Finally, the committee amendments to the bill eliminate the provision requiring that all funds of the commission and the foundation are to be transferred to the State Treasurer for deposit in a special dedicated account.

### COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

The committee amended the bill to:

(1) clarify that funding deposited in the U.S.S. New Jersey Educational Museum Fund is to be annually appropriated to the Home Port Alliance;

(2) eliminate the requirement that all funds of the commission and the foundation are to be transferred to the State Treasurer for deposit in a special dedicated account; and

(3) omit the term "acquisition" from the statutes establishing the issuance of the "Battleship U.S.S. New Jersey" license plate.
