15 This bill amends the "New Jersey Hall of Fame Act," P.L.2005, 16 232 (C.5:10-6.4 et al.) to authorize the New Jersey Sports and 17 Exposition Authority (the "authority") to establish and operate the 18 New Jersey Hall of Fame project (the "project") at a site either 19 within the Meadowlands complex, or within this State, but outside 20 of the Meadowlands complex, that is determined by the authority to be appropriate to meet the requirements of the project and to best 21 serve the interests of the public. The bill requires the authority to 22 23 adopt to the maximum extent feasible the recommendations of the 24 New Jersey Hall of Fame Advisory Commission (the 25 "commission"), established pursuant to section 4 of P.L.2005, c.232 26 (C.5:10-6.6) with regard to the project location.

Under current law, the authority is authorized to establish and

This bill would expand the area within which the project could be

The Assembly Budget Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 2232, with committee amendments.

The bill, as amended, amends the "New Jersey Hall of Fame Act," P.L.2005, 232 (C.5:10-6.4 et al.), which authorizes the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority (the "authority") to establish the New Jersey Hall of Fame project (the "project") and to establish a corporation to operate and manage the project. The bill allows the project to be located anywhere within this State, not just within the Meadowlands complex as now provided. The bill moves statutory responsibility for determining the project site from the authority to the commissioners of the New Jersey Hall of Fame Advisory Commission and the trustees of the Foundation for the New Jersey Hall of Fame, acting jointly.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill was not certified as requiring a fiscal note.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

The amendments:

(1) incorporate the provision reassigning statutory responsibility for determining the project location and remove, as no longer necessary, a provision for this siting decision to reflect recommendations of the New Jersey Hall of Fame Advisory Commission;

(2) revise the language concerning the management corporation to require, rather than simply authorize, its establishment;

(3) specify that the voting membership of the board of directors of the managing corporation is to consist of the trustees of the Foundation for the New Jersey Hall of Fame and may, if the corporation's bylaws so provide, include members of the Advisory Commission; and

(4) clarify the informational role of the Advisory Commission with respect to the operation and management of the project.

The Senate Wagering, Tourism & Historic Preservation Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 2232 (1R).

This bill amends the "New Jersey Hall of Fame Act," P.L.2005, 232 (C.5:10-6.4 et al.), which authorizes the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority to establish the New Jersey Hall of Fame project and to establish a corporation to operate and manage the project.

The bill allows the project to be located anywhere within this State, and moves statutory responsibility for determining the project site from the NJSEA to the commissioners of the New Jersey Hall of Fame Advisory Commission and the trustees of the Foundation for the New Jersey Hall of Fame, acting jointly. The bill also revises the language concerning the New Jersey Hall of Fame corporation to require, rather than simply authorize, its establishment. The bill specifies that the voting membership of the board of directors of the corporation is to consist of the trustees of the Foundation for the New Jersey Hall of Fame and may, if the corporation's bylaws so provide, include members of the Advisory Commission. Finally, the bill clarifies the informational role of the Advisory Commission with respect to the operation and management of the project.

As reported by the committee, this bill is identical to Senate, No. 1768.

The commission shall also develop policies to improve the 32 image of New Jersey, promote the heritage of the residents of this 33 State and instill pride in the State by increasing the public's 34 awareness of the contributions made to society by past and present 35 residents of New Jersey, make recommendations for local and State 36 actions to follow up the commission's goals and consider such other 37 matters relating to the accomplishment of its goals as the 38 commission may deem appropriate. 39 The commission shall be authorized, within the limits of the c. 40 funds made available to it for its purposes, to employ an executive 41 director and professional, technical and administrative personnel 42 and to contract for such professional and administrative services, 43 and incur traveling and other miscellaneous expenses as it may 44 deem necessary, in order to perform its duties. No member of the 45 commission shall engage in any business transaction or professional 46 activity for profit with the State of New Jersey. Employees of the 47 commission shall not be construed to be employees of the State of 48 New Jersey.

STATEMENT

15 This bill amends the "New Jersey Hall of Fame Act," P.L.2005, 16 232 (C.5:10-6.4 et al.) to authorize the New Jersey Sports and 17 Exposition Authority (the "authority") to establish and operate the 18 New Jersey Hall of Fame project (the "project") at a site either 19 within the Meadowlands complex, or within this State, but outside 20 of the Meadowlands complex, that is determined by the authority to be appropriate to meet the requirements of the project and to best 21 serve the interests of the public. The bill requires the authority to 22 23 adopt to the maximum extent feasible the recommendations of the 24 New Jersey Hall of Fame Advisory Commission (the 25 "commission"), established pursuant to section 4 of P.L.2005, c.232 26 (C.5:10-6.6) with regard to the project location.

Under current law, the authority is authorized to establish and
operate such a project solely within the Meadowlands complex.
This bill would expand the area within which the project could be
established and operated to include a location within this State but
outside of the Meadowlands complex.

The Senate Wagering, Tourism & Historic Preservation Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Senate Bill No. 1768.

This bill amends the "New Jersey Hall of Fame Act," P.L.2005, 232 (C.5:10-6.4 et al.), which authorizes the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority to establish the New Jersey Hall of Fame project and to establish a corporation to operate and manage the project.

As amended by the committee, the bill allows the project to be located anywhere within this State, and moves statutory responsibility for determining the project site from the NJSEA to the commissioners of the New Jersey Hall of Fame Advisory Commission and the trustees of the Foundation for the New Jersey Hall of Fame, acting jointly. The bill also revises the language concerning the New Jersey Hall of Fame corporation to require, rather than simply authorize, its establishment. The bill specifies that the voting membership of the board of directors of the corporation is to consist of the trustees of the Foundation for the New Jersey Hall of Fame and may, if the corporation's bylaws so provide, include members of the Advisory Commission. Finally, the bill clarifies the informational role of the Advisory Commission with respect to the operation and management of the project.

As reported by the committee, this bill is identical to Assembly, No. 2232 (1R).
