AN ACT concerning crimes, and supplementing chapter 113 of Title
2A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Any person who shall **knowingly** offer, give or entice any
2 child ***under the age of 18 years,*** to take or accept any treat,
3 candy, gift or food which is poisonous, deleterious or harmful to
4 the health or welfare of such child, is ***[guilty of a misdemeanor]***
5 **a disorderly person*.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
