An Acr concerning crimes, and supplementing chapter 113 of Title 2A of the New Jersey Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. Any person who shall *knowingly* offer, give or entice any
- 2 child **under the age of 18 years, ** to take or accept any treat,
- 3 candy, gift or food which is poisonous, deleterious or harmful to
- 4 the health or welfare of such child, is *[guilty of a misdemeanor]*
- 5 *a disorderly person*.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
