# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

#### INTRODUCED JUNE 3, 1968

#### By Senators H. A. KELLY, ITALIANO and MILLER

### Referred to Committee on Taxation

An Act to amend "An act relating to the powers and duties of the Director of the Division of Taxation in the Department of the Treasury with respect to State aid for schools, and making an appropriation therefor," approved June 30, 1954 (P. L. 1954 c. 86).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1954, chapter 86 (C. 54:1-35.1) is amended 2 to read as follows:

1. On or before October 1 in each year the Director of the Divi-3 sion of Taxation, in the State Department of the Treasury shall 4 promulgate a table of equalized valuations to be used in the cal-5 culation and apportionment of distributions pursuant to the State 6 School Aid Act of 1954. Such table shall be deemed to have been  $\overline{7}$ promulgated on the day when the director shall have completed 8 the delivery of a certified copy thereof to the Commissioner of 9 10 Education and the mailing of a certified copy thereof to the municipal clerk of each municipality, [and] to the secretary of each 11 county board of taxation and, by certified mail, to the mayor or 12other chief executive officer of any municipality for which the 1314 equalized valuation so certified exceeds by 10% or more the equalized valuation determined for the preceding year. The table 15 for each year and any revision thereof shall be kept as a public 16 record in each office to which it is sent and in the office of the 17 Director of Taxation. 18

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
