INTRODUCED JANUARY 29, 1968

AN ACT concerning pensioners in public employment and repealing chapter 3 of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, if a former
2 member of any pension fund or retirement system, contributory
3 or noncontributory, established under any law of this or any other
4 State, who has been granted a pension or retirement allowance for
5 any cause other than vesting or deferred retirement, becomes em-
6 ployed again in a position which makes him eligible to be a mem-
7 ber of another pension fund or retirement system established
8 under any law of this State, such person shall not be enrolled in
9 such other pension fund or retirement system if he is eligible to
10 receive such pension or retirement allowance.

11 If such a former member has been enrolled in such other pen-
12 sion fund or retirement system as of the effective date of this act,
13 his membership in such other fund or system shall be hereby ter-
14 minated and he or his beneficiary shall be permitted to receive a
15 refund of his contributions to such fund or system upon the filing
16 of a proper application therefor.

1 2. Chapter 3 of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes, and all amend-
2 ments and supplements thereto, is repealed.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill will eliminate restrictions on the amount a retired public employee may earn through New Jersey public employment. At the same time it will prevent the enrollment of a retired public employee in another public pension fund.
