AN ACT authorizing certain county correction officers to exercise police powers, and amending section 2A:154-3 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 2A:154-3 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 2A:154-3. All court attendants, *sheriff's officers and county cor-*
4 *rection officers* in the competitive class of civil service who have
5 been or who may hereafter be appointed by the sheriff *or board of*
6 *chosen freeholders* of any county in this State shall, by virtue of
7 such appointment and in addition to any other power or authority,
8 be empowered to act as officers for the detection, apprehension,
9 arrest and conviction of offenders against the law.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
