- An Act authorizing certain county correction officers to exercise police powers, and amending section 2A:154-3 of the New Jersey Statutes.
- 1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. Section 2A:154-3 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to 2 read as follows:

2A:154-3. All court attendants, sheriff's officers and county correction officers in the competitive class of civil service who have been or who may hereafter be appointed by the sheriff or board of chosen freeholders of any county in this State shall, by virtue of such appointment and in addition to any other power or authority, he empowered to act as officers for the detection, apprehension, arrest and conviction of offenders against the law.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
