A SUPPLEMENT to the "Farmland Assessment Act of 1964," approved May 11, 1964 (P. L. 1964, c. 48).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. In any municipality in which a program of revaluation of all property in the municipality has been or shall be undertaken and $\mathbf{2}$ completed in time to be reflected in the assessments for the next 3 succeeding tax year but not in sufficient time to permit taxpayers 4 to make applications prior to October 1 of the pretax year for the 56 valuation, assessment and taxation of their lands for the ensuing tax year on the basis of being actively devoted to agricultural 7or horticultural use, any such application which has been or shall 8 be filed with the assessor after October 1, and prior to December 9 31 of the pretax year, shall be deemed to have been timely made 10for the tax year next succeeding completion of the revaluation 11 program, notwithstanding any provision to the contrary of the act 12to which this act is a supplement or of any other law, and the taxes 13of any applicant whose lands qualify for valuation, assessment 14 and taxation as lands actively devoted to agricultural or horticul-15tural use shall be adjusted accordingly for the tax year commencing 16 17January 1 next succeeding completion of the revaluation program and credited or debited, as the case may be, against any taxes due 18or to become due on such lands. 19

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
